Guaranteed Snow?

Well not really. But participating OFSC members can get a Snow Promise payout of \$200 this season if it snows less than 31cm from Dec 25th, 2010 to March 15, 2011. To qualify for this program, purchase your 2011 Seasonal Permit on or before Dec 1st, 2010 then go online at snowguarantee.ca no later than Dec 16, 2010 and for \$10 (tax included) you can have your very own Snow Promise!

Buy your permits online

Don't have time to run out and visit one of our retail outlets for your 2011 Seasonal Permit? Why not purchase it online? It's secure, easy and you don't have to leave the comfort of your home. Visit www.ofsc.on.ca and your permit is just a click away. There is a \$10 postage fee for the 1st permit and \$2 for additional permits.

New trail status reporting for OFSC

Not sure if a trail is open or what condition it is in? The OFSC has revamped their trail status section on their website so now you can click on the section of trail you wish to ride. This new system will be map-based and colour coded for various trail conditions. Another new feature to be implemented over this season is GPS tracking on all OFSC groomers. This will allow you to know when your favorite trail was last groomed!

Trail Permits

The fee schedule for the 2011 OFSC/MTO Trail Permit:

\$200.00 if purchased on/before December 1st, 2010

\$250.00 if purchased after December 1st, 2010

\$140.00 – Seven day permit

\$100.00 – Three day permit

\$125.00 – Classic permit (available for sled model year 1996 or older and only available from an OFSC district office)
