### Trail Permits

The fee schedule for the 2005/2006 OFSC/MTO Trail Permit is as follows:

- \$180.00 if purchased on/before December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2005
- \$230.00 if purchased after December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2005
- \$100.00 – Seven day permit
- \$35.00 – One day permit
- \$10.00 – Replacement Permit

One-Day permits are available in limited quantities and are intended for the use of out-of-province visitors and special events.
