The SVSA is looking for volunteers who would like to become a Trail Warden for the 2002/03 season. A Trail Warden is a public relations person first and foremost. The mandate is to make certain that all snowmobilers travelling on Prescribed Trails have a valid Snowmobile Trail Permit affixed in the proper place. You have the authority under the Trespass to Property Act to file a Notice of Trespass and proceed with that issuance through the provincial court system; resulting in a conviction.
